

Guidelines Governing the Establishment of the International and Cross-strait Cooperation and Development Committee

- I. The International and Cross-strait Cooperation and Development Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Committee) is established to improve Wenzao's international reputation, broaden its faculty and students' international horizons, enhance their international mobility, and strengthen international and cross-strait academic cooperation and cultural exchange.
- II. The Committee is composed of the President, Vice President, Dean of Academic Affairs, Dean of Student Affairs, Dean of Research and Development, Dean of General Affairs, Dean of Office of International and Cross-strait Cooperation, Director of Accounting Office, college deans, and department (graduate institute) chairpersons and director of centers.
- III. The President serves as the convener, and the Dean of Office of International and Cross-strait Cooperation as the executive secretary of the Committee. At least one meeting should be convened every semester. A special meeting may be convened if necessary. Relevant personnel may be invited to attend such meetings.
- IV. The duties of the Committee include:
 - (I) Plan and develop a vision concerning international and cross-strait academic cooperation and exchange.
 - (II) Discuss affairs related to the signing of a cooperation agreement between the University and a foreign academic institution, along with the contents of the agreement.
 - (III) Strengthen the cooperation and exchanges between the University and a foreign academic institution, as well as student exchange programs.
 - (IV) Assist in the recruitment of foreign students.
 - (V) Handle affairs related to the promotion of campus internationalization and international and cross-strait academic cooperation and cultural exchange.
- V. Administrative affairs of the Committee should be handled by the Office of International and Cross-strait Cooperation.
- VI. The Guidelines become effective after being approved at the Executive Meeting and ratified by the President. Amendments must follow the same procedure.
